We are able to monitor the web content visited by students using either academy or personal electronic devices when logged into the network.

## **Around the Campus**

BOA Digital has a city-centre campus and most of you will be using public transport to travel to and from the academy. Like most city-centres, Birmingham has an excellent safety record, but you are still advised to adopt a sensible approach. The academy is a fifteen minute walk from New Street Station and a ten minute walk from the Bull Ring, the main bus drop-off areas and Moor Street Station. Have a mobile phone with you and let family or friends know when you are expected to be returning home each day. For safety, always walk in groups. Use Jennens Road to get to the stations and ensure you walk up the steps and over, NOT under the Bullring Centre bridge. It is also NOT advisable to use the Eastside Park as a route to/from BOA. Students are INSTRUCTED NOT TO GO INTO THE PARK and are INSTRUCTED to use Jennens Road to make their way to/from the city centre.
