



Pastoral Care

All students will be in mixed-gender tutor groups within year 7.

Miss Deb Hart is the member of the Senior Leadership Team with responsibility for pastoral care.

Your tutor is the key person concerned with your welfare, guidance and academic progress. You will see your tutor for a 1 hour Personal Development lesson (to include Relationships and Sex Education) each week and then for form time every day.

Your tutor is the first person you should talk to if you have any concerns.

The Designated Safeguarding Lead is Miss Deb Hart, Assistant Principal. Miss Hart can be approached regarding any safeguarding concern.

Behaviour and Attendance

At BOA Digital Technologies we have expectations of each other's behaviour on and off the premises. This helps us work together. Please read the Code of Conduct Policy included in this pack.

Attendance is an essential factor of success. 100% expected attendance, a minimum of 95%. Below 95% will trigger immediate intervention.

Café and Canteen
